

INDEPENDENCE HS CHEERLEADER/MASCOT CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

In compliance with the cheerleading constitution established by the Frisco ISD Code of Conduct the following list was compiled to reinforce the expectations of our cheerleaders and mascots as campus leaders. We believe this system will keep the standards and morals of IHS cheerleaders high and reflect positive characteristics for all FISD expectations.

The following is a guideline. Certain behaviors not listed may also result in sitting out, strikes, or other consequences deemed appropriate by the coaches.

Actions that may result in sitting out of parts or all of a game, event or pep rally	Possible Additional Consequences
Wearing jewelry at the start or at any time during a practice/game/event	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Not in correct uniform/practice attire; including, but not limited to, wrong shirt/shorts, missing/wrong bow, incorrect hair, missing poms or megaphone, colored socks, appropriate nail color/length during cheering season, wrong color or showing bra with uniform etc. Not dressing up on designated HOCO/spirit days	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Tardy to practice/game/event after 10 minutes that is not excused	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
School Dress Code Violation	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Showing public displays of affection/kissing others in uniform	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Acting inappropriately (as determined by coaches) before, during halftime breaks, or after sporting events - including, but not limited to, talking to friends during game, using cell phone during game/performance, etc.	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Missing a game/practice/event (unexcused)	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Actions that will result in a strike	Possible Additional Consequences
Arguing/disrespecting teammates or coach	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Failure to show other teams respect while they are performing/playing	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Negative report about behavior/attitude from teacher or administration	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
Code of Conduct violation, including, but not limited to, Social Media Contract violation	Other consequences up to coaches discretion

Bullying	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
TNL for behavior / Saturday School	Other consequences up to coaches discretion
ISS	Suspension from 2 events and other consequences up to coaches' discretion
OSS	Suspension 2 from events and other consequences up to coaches' discretion

1 Strike = Suspension from ONE event + conference with coach and cheerleader, parent notified by phone call and/or email (unless it is ISS/OSS)

2 Strikes = Suspension from TWO events + conference with coach and cheerleader, parent notified by phone call and/or meeting in person (if requested)

3 Strikes = Dismissal from squad

INDEPENDENCE HS CHEERLEADER/MASCOT WRITTEN NOTICE FORM

Per the Fisd High School Cheerleader Code of Conduct & Guidelines, the following will apply regarding written notices/warnings in conjunction with removal from the squad.

- Any cheerleader that exhibits an action listed under the behavior category will receive a strike.
- (1st Strike): Parents will be notified; written notice will be signed by parent and cheerleader, and cheerleader will be benched for one performance.
- (2nd Strike): Parents will be notified, written notice will be signed by parent and cheerleader, and cheerleader will be benched for two performances.
- (3rd Strike): Results in the cheerleader's removal from the cheer squad for the remainder of the school year.

*Per conduct and discipline system, this form must be turned in the following day signed by parent and cheerleader or the cheerleader will receive consequences per day form is past due.
